



MEMBER NOTICE

On the 29th March 2018 the Committee, in accordance with Rule 82 of the Tattersalls Club approved an update to the Clubs By-Laws.

82. The Committee shall have power from time to time when, and as they think fit, to pass, alter, amend, or rescind By-laws for the regulation of the affairs of the Club, provided such By-laws are not inconsistent or opposed to the Rules. The By-laws shall be exhibited for the inspection of Members.

These will be posted and available to all Members for review and comment. The laws will apply as of the 10th May 2018. Of particular note is the revised Dress Code which is reproduced below.

DRESS CODE

Whilst contemporary standards and common sense are the guiding principles of the dress code, Members are expected to dress and respect the rich traditions of the Club. As a rule of thumb business attire is always appropriate. Members and Guests will be denied entry if they do not meet the Clubs dress standards. Members must ensure their guests are aware and conform to dress code.

Members Bar & Dining Room – Acceptable:

Business Attire is preferred but jackets and ties are optional.

For Men, a collared Shirt, Tailored Dress Shorts, Jeans or trousers are the minimum requirement. Enclosed shoes must be worn at all times.

For Women, dresses, skirts, jeans, dress trousers and shorts are the minimum requirement.

Members Bar & Dining Room – Not Acceptable:

Collarless Shirts, unless a jacket or collared sweater is worn over it.

All sporting attire including, sports shorts & tracksuits.

Recreational or casual footwear is not allowed and includes thongs, sandals (dress sandals are acceptable for women) or untidy footwear.

When not conforming to these standards members wishing to access or depart the Athletic Department must move swiftly through the Club lobby. Shorts, sports shoes and boots, tracksuits and other sports gear are not permitted in the Members Bar & Dining Room

Athletic Department:

Clothing must be worn at all times outside of the Change Rooms.

Pool Area: Club issued or personal swimwear is the minimum requirement in the pool area, sauna & steam room.

Gym Floor & Classes: The minimum requirement is shorts and closed toe shoes at all times for hygiene and safety reasons.
